221005/4	<b>To receive comments and concerns from the public:</b> Car parking in the Square continued to be an issue. The Chairman invited a resident to give his views based on his professional experience with another county council. Better signage and lining could be utilised, but this would need to be weighed against increased urbanisation of the village. Restrictions on parking were unlikely because of the difficulties of enforcement. The Trust and the Village Hall were continuing to liaise on potential schemes. The County Council could offer advice and support. It was agreed to raise with County Councillor Mark Mackenzie-Charrington at the next meeting and retain on the agenda.	
221005/5	<b>Queens Jubilee Commemorative Tree Seat:</b> Cllr Rimmer reported that the seat had been installed. It would be added to the Council's assets register. Value was confirmed at £1700	Clerk

221005/8	<b>Xmas Tree arrangements:</b> the Chairman reported that as in previous years, residents of Castlett Farm had kindly agreed to sponsor the Xmas Tree and mulled wine. It was agreed that residents providing the electric for the lights should be offered some recompense by the Council due to the high cost of electricity. A budget of £50 was agreed.
